

Boehringer Ingelheim FENS Research Award 2020

Award for outstanding and innovative scientific contributions in any area of neuroscience research

Personal Prize

25 000 €

Candidates may either apply themselves or be proposed by a fellow neuroscientist. Candidates must be under 40 years of age and either be of European origin or affiliated with a European institution.

The award will be presented in Glasgow during the 12th FENS Forum of European Neuroscience (11th – 15th July, 2020). The prize winner will be asked to give a special lecture at the meeting.

Deadline for applications is 31st May, 2019

Applications should include the following documents:

- ▶ Short CV
- ▶ List of publications
- ▶ Short summary of the main research topic documented by key publications
- ▶ Brief outline of the subsequent research project the prize money would support
- ▶ Names and email addresses of two key scientists in the field willing to write a letter of recommendation on request
