Are you an individual?

Individuals can become a FENS member via their national or single-discipline society or by applying for individual membership. Thus, residents from countries that do not have a national FENS member society can apply for individual membership and enjoy an extensive package of benefits.

FENS membership is automatically granted to the individual members of all FENS member societies. If your national neuroscience or single discipline society is already a member of FENS, then apply directly to them for membership to join FENS.

Note: you cannot become an individual member of FENS if you reside in a country where there is a FENS society. Please check the full list of national member societies below, please apply for membership through a FENS society instead.
