

Transportation

Vienna is proud of its public transport network that will reliably take you to any part of the city. However, in the inner city, you can also make most routes by foot within 20-30 Minutes, and you get to know the city that way! To speed up, you could also change to biking.

Public transport ("Wiener Linien")

For $17,10 \in$ you can buy a one-week ticket for all public transport within Vienna. A single ticket comes at $2,40 \in$. Attention - this does not cover the whole transfer to the airport, since it's located outside of the city! You can easily buy tickets at booths in each subway station, or online using the App "WienMobil".

Google maps is your friend with regards to public transport and gives very reliable routes!

Public transport outside of Vienna (ÖBB)

The ÖBB trains will take you away to visit another city or just for a day-hike. You will have to buy an extra ticket whenever you leave Vienna. You can do so at automatic booths at the train stations or online: ÖBB Tickets.

If you already have a city ticket for Vienna, indicate the corresponding box and the price will be a bit lower.

Again, google maps is pretty good at finding the right train to somewhere! However, it doesn't always know about public busses outside Vienna, for which you can refer to <u>AnachB</u>

City Airport

The "City Airport Train (CAT)" is rather expensive (14.90€) and only saves you ~5mins. You can just as well take a normal

ÖBB train (e.g. S7), but you will have to buy a separate ticket (see above) for 4.40€ or 2.00€, depending on whether you already have a city ticket for Vienna *Kernzone*.

How to reach the conference location

The easiest way to reach the conference location is to get off the subway line **"U2" at "Messe- Prater"**, from there it's a 2 minute walk. The "Jump the FENS" event in "Praterdom" is right between that stop and the stop "Praterstern", where the subway lines "U1" and "U2", the tram-lines "O" and "5", the bus "80a", as well as the "S-Bahn" trains will take you. Bike Rental

Wien Mobil Bicycle rental allows you to pick up and bring back a bike at any of their stations distributed in town (map). It costs 0,60 €/hr, and you need to download the "Next Bike app" or "WienMobil" app: WienMobil bicycle rental - vienna.info

How to survive summer heat in Vienna

There is some peak performances Vienna isn't that proud of - unfortunately, it is the fastest-warming cities in Europe. In summer, you can expect temperatures up to 36 degrees Celsius during the day, and as low as 15 during the night (previous years: <u>Lufttemperatur Dezember 2021 bis Dezember 2023 - Offizielle</u> <u>Statistik der Stadt Wien</u>).

Thus, if you want to explore the city, don't forget sunscreen and caps, but also carry a light jacket for the evenings.

Fortunately, there are many options to escape the heat. Right next to the conference venue, you can go for a walk in "**Prater**", which consists of large green areas and an amusement park that dates back to the early 19th century! If you have the time, you could also leave the city for **hiking trip**, such as for this route along the "Vienna water pipes" (pic right): <u>Vienna Water Pipeline Hiking Trail</u>



For **swimming**, you can reach "Stadionbad" by walking 30 minutes through "Prater" from the conference venue (Google maps will reliably guide you).

Alternatively, go for a swim in "Alte Donau" (e.g. from the U2 stop "Donaustadtbrücke, pic left) or at Danube Island (Donauinsel) - please check out this map: <u>Danube Island</u>

"Gänsehäufel" is a bit further away but very nice, ask Google maps for the fastest route!

All of these swimming locations are also indicated on the <u>SCHS</u> <u>Recommendation map!</u>


